- Matriculation or CBSE curriculum.
- Medium size school or large school.
- Reputation of School in the neighbourhood.
- Consistent result performance in Xth & XIIth Std.
- Facilities for sports and games.
- School environment – garden and ambience.
- School location – free from traffic, noise and air pollution and close to home.
- After school Programs, Sports, Clubs, NEET Coaching.
- Availability of core subjects - Science, Maths, Commerce, Arts in Higher Secondary.
- Approach to learning: student project-individual and group practical skills.
- Discipline Policy and Dress Code.
- Student Teacher ration less than 35:1 or above 35:1
- Opportunity to participate in extracurricular activities and competitions.
- Well – stocked library
- Focus of the school – whether commercial or service oriented.
- Access to computer and smart board.
- Availability of Scholarships. School respects religious and government holidays.

- Welcoming attitude towards parents.
- Affordable fee structure.
- Individual care for students.
